

PUBLIC MEETING – MARCH 27TH AT 7PM AT THE OMEO COMMUNITY HUB

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING: AMALGAMATION OF THE COMMUNITY HUB COMMITTEE & THE OMEO SOLDIERS MEMORIAL HALL COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT

With an ageing membership of the Hall committee and the establishment of the Community Hub it was suggested by the Hall committee to amalgamate with the Hub. This proposal was seen as being possible by the Hub committee. Investigation with East Gippsland Shire Council has commenced.

We need the opinion of the Omeo community to discuss the feasibility of this process progressing. If you wish to have your opinion heard on the following items please attend.

- future of Hall and Hub remaining independent of each other with regards to management
- amalgamation of the governance of the two facilities under the one umbrella / committee (of management)
- process required for the amalgamation to occur should those present at the meeting decide that this course of action will be taken
- requirements for the future
 - o incorporation, new (acceptable) title of the group, banking (signatories & accounts to be held), tax obligations, public liability insurance
 - Clarification of Public Liability coverage provided by EGSC when the Hall is booked for various functions.
 - Agreements explanation alignment of the two with EGSC funding provided by EGSC for operations - continuation for the Hall
 - Hall to be known as? With no intention of removing the memorabilia or the signage on the front window of the hall foyer.
 - Current exec position holders within the two groups will need to meld together with some current position holders not being required to continue in the role.

Thomas Toke - Dead Cocks Don't Crow A secretive and violent man I have allowed Thomas Toke to narrate his life story. Only Toke could explain his actions and reactions to the old world that rejected

him and to the new world that he helped to form.

You fools, you think that you know all about your past, you sit on your computers and tap into all manner of information yet you will not find me mentioned there. My history is held in the records of long since discarded newspapers and musty records hidden in the archives and libraries of England and Australia.

Who am I? I am Thomas Toke, alias Thomas Tookey, alias Thomas Toak. I was born in England in 1811 and transported to Sydney, Australia in 1826. I endured all the hellholes of incarceration within New South Wales, Van Diemen's Land, Norfolk Island and Victoria and I survived. No hangman's noose for me, even though I murdered my fair share of individuals. I also stole horses, resorted to blackmail and terrorised whole communities. I crossed paths with such great characters as Redmond Barry, the Tichborne claimant, Sir George Stephen (father of the anti-slavery movement), forebears of ANZAC veterans and Rolf Boldrewood (Thomas Brown). In your ignorance you believe that Ned Kelly was a "great" bushranger. He was a flash in the pan. I was the true bushranger. After a very successful life of crime I died in my bed of natural causes at the ripe age of seventy-six. Heed my words well and give thanks to the likes of me who gave you a rich and colourful heritage to cherish. You don't believe me, you think I boast, well read my tale and then see what you think.

I charge you with the responsibility of passing on my story to the next Generation and remind you that once in a while dead cocks do crow!
