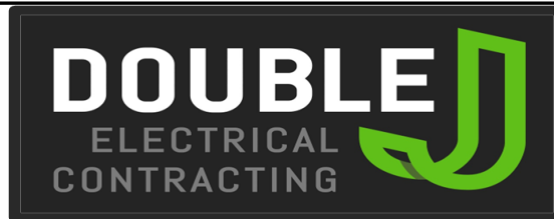

Stella McCoy and Empire Day

“On 27th October, at the Shire Hall, Omeo, a concert was held in aid of the Wounded Soldiers. The concert was organised by Miss Stella McCoy and her pupils. A large and appreciative audience was present, as a result of the effort the fund will benefit by the sum of £15. The program opened with a tableau vivant entitled ‘All Nations’ representing every nation and country at present engaged in the war on the side of the Allies.

The curtain was raised showing Britannia holding her trident in her hand. Alongside of her stood John Bull, both faithfully and traditionally depicted. On either end of the stage stood two boy scouts both at attention. One of these scouts acted as usher and announced each character representing the various nations as each came on the stage and took their place to the accompaniments of appropriate music.

This tableau was the most pleasing and attractive feature of the program, and stirred every person present. Each representative of the various nations was portrayed true to life. The costumes must have taken no end of labor to produce, and reflected great credit on those responsible for their making.

Pianoforte solos and duets were rendered by the pupils, in which they show proficiency and reflected credit on their teacher. Other tableaux and action songs made up an enjoyable program.

A pleasant evening was brought to a close with the singing of the various National Anthems of the Allies.
